Criteria for this award include:

- Completion of three (3) DST courses, DST 501 and two (2) additional DST courses;
- High academic performance;
- Ability to advance the understanding of equality and inclusion;
- Demonstrated commitment to improving life for other students;
- Contributing to the reputation of the school.

The following are to be provided:

- 1. Name of person being nominated (including address, phone and email).
- 2. Nomination paragraph stating reasons.
- 3. Reference letter of support from faculty member or employer.
- 4. Students may nominate themselves or be nominated by another student or faculty member.

The selection will be made by an awards committee including faculty

and representation from the School of Disability.

All materials must be submitted through the AwardSpring system through the university.
